



Pool Admission Policies for Guests of Davis Lake Members:

Members must accompany guests at all times.

DAILY visit Guest Pass:

- \$5.00/DAY per GUEST

Guest Punch-Pass Card:

- \$20.00 per card
- 10 VISITS per CARD
- 1 PUNCH equals 1 GUEST per day
- Residents may purchase at pool desk or clubhouse office
- Please note that homeowners may use only 1 punch pass per day
- **Limit of 10 guests per household per day** (Does not include private rentals)
- These do not expire so if someone has an old one that still has punches available for use on it, they are allowed to use it until all 10 punches have been punched out & used.

“VIP” Guest Admission:

- Davis Lake Homeowners may bring up to SIX immediate (6) **RELATIVES** to the pool per day as VIP's.
- Relatives are defined as somebody of the same family **related by** birth, marriage or by adoption (parents, siblings, uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces, grandparents, grandchildren).
- They must reside **more than 50 miles from Davis Lake and all must provide I.D. showing residence.**
- The homeowner must provide a list of relatives and denote the duration of their stay to the Davis Lake Aquatic & Event Director.
- VIP Limitations are 10 days **MAX per guest. You may use 2 passes per individual per year with at least 30 days between passes.**
- Homeowners must request VIP pass at least **2 days prior to & not on the day of arrival.**
- **VIP passes are issued at the Clubhouse Office only during hours of operation and must be picked up by the homeowner. They can be picked up at the Pool Check-in desk under the last name of the homeowner who requested the passes.**
- Homeowners with VIP guests without passes or those over the limit of 6 must pay the guest fee of their choosing: Daily OR Guest Punch Pass

No exceptions, Please understand we must follow this rule for the benefit, fairness and safety of all homeowners. Thank you for your patience and understanding.



ID Cards

Davis Lake ID cards are required to enter the pool for Davis Lake residents. ID cards will only be issued to the homeowner(s) on record, their children and other household residents whose legal permanent address can be proven to be the same as the home owners. Davis Lake ID cards will not be issued for family members or friends visiting for an extended period of time. (See Guest and VIP guests sections above for those applicable policies.) Any exception requests must be submitted to the DLCA board at dlcboard@davislake.org.

Policy for Rental Homes in Davis Lake, Woodcroft at Davis Lake, Legacy at Davis Lake & Ridge at Davis Lake:

The Homeowner of Record must complete the process on the "Amenity Usage Policy for Tenants of Davis Lake Properties" Form. This is in accordance to the covenants and restrictions and at the discretion of the DLCA. An original signed and notarized affidavit must be received by Davis Lake Community Association via U.S. Mail along with a current copy of the lease agreement with all tenants' names and lease expiration date. PLEASE NOTE: Until a valid affidavit is received, the property owner's good standing is verified, and ID cards are issued, you will not be allowed access to Davis Lake amenities. There will be no exceptions to this rule. If you are a tenant and are interested in the use of the amenities here in Davis Lake you must speak with your landlord about assigning their privileges to you.

Sitter/Caretaker Passes:

Sitter/Caretaker passes will be available to Davis Lake residents. We understand that many of us need to work during the day or have other obligations. For those who have Sitters/Caretakers at least 12 years old caring for your children this summer you can stop into the Clubhouse Office during Clubhouse Office hours to complete and sign a Sitter Pass Covenant. The sitter will need to have a photo taken and both the resident and the sitter will need to sign the document. A sitter that does NOT live in Davis Lake will need to provide ID. Those residents with outside sitters will also be required to purchase guest passes for your sitter if they choose to use the pool while caring for your children. If the Sitter/Caretaker is a Davis Lake resident they will need to have both ID's, Caretaker AND their Davis Lake ID, updated and present for admittance to the pool. If a Sitter/Caretaker watches multiple families in Davis Lake, they will need only one ID, however, will need to have a form on file for each family. This pass must be renewed each year as well.

The Davis Lake Pool Opening Day: Are You Prepared?

Please don't wait until the last minute...you will need your Davis Lake ID cards for pool access. If you already have an ID card you do NOT need to get a new card unless you have lost it. The cost for a replacement is \$5 per card. Only those without ID's will need to make arrangements to have new ones issued. All ID's, whether they are new or not, need to have a renewal sticker on them for pool admittance and to utilize all other Davis Lake amenities. A Facility Usage Contract will need to be filled out and turned into the Davis Lake Aquatic & Event Director at the Clubhouse Office in order to receive your renewal stickers, new amenity codes and/or receive a new ID card.

Membership ID Card/Pool Pass

Did you know that your Membership ID card is also your Pool Pass? The Davis Lake Board would like to encourage everyone to carry their ID card with them when they attend social events and use the common grounds/amenities (pool, tennis courts, fitness room, field, clubhouse, volleyball court, walking trails & lake). ID cards are required by all residents 6 and up for entrance to the pool. This will ensure our community is being used by those who are entitled and not those from outside the Davis Lake Community. Please know that our local law enforcement may also ask to see your card. This will help with safety issues within our community.

If you are new to the neighborhood, have never had a card made or have lost your card (Note: There is a \$5 charge to replace lost ID cards) you can stop by the clubhouse during regular office hours and have a photo taken. If you have never received an ID before, are updating from an underage card to a 12 & older card, changing addresses or a married name on an ID card- there is not a \$5 fee. Before receiving your ID card, an adult property owner will need to read and sign the Facility Usage Contract. This occurs each and every year.

PLEASE NOTE: All families will be asked to complete an *Up-to-Date* Facility Usage Contract each year. These are available online and at the Clubhouse Office. If you are renting a home in Davis Lake you will need to have the property owner complete and sign an Amenity Usage Policy for Tenants- this would assign their rights for use of the amenities to the renters. A copy of this form is online in the Property Owners section of our website and available at the Clubhouse Office. An original signed and notarized affidavit must be received by Davis Lake via U.S. Mail along with a copy of the lease agreement with all tenants' names and lease expiration date. A new form must be completed *each year* that the tenant resides at their home.

Until a valid affidavit is received, the property owner's good standing is verified, and ID cards are issued, you will not be allowed access to Davis Lake amenities. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
